

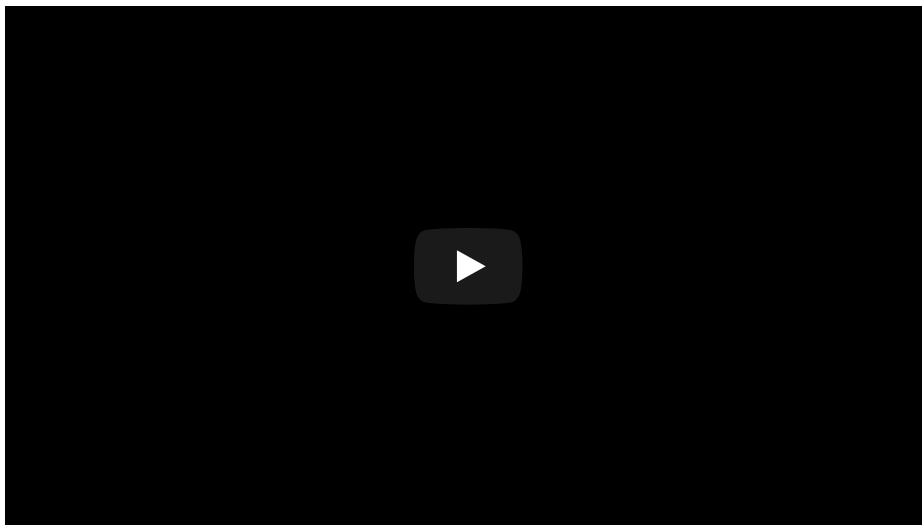
Supporting you through COVID-19
